Chrysler 26

One of the most cruise-able, race-able 26-footers to breeze onto the sailing scene in years, Chrysler 26 comes with swing keel and rudder to make her easily trailerable, or with a fully molded fixed keel and spade rudder. She's available with a built-in transom mount for "Sailor" outboards, or a $7\frac{1}{2}$ -hp. diesel auxiliary with sailboat drive.

She's extremely stable, yet instantly responsive. She comes with mainsail, genoa, standing and running rigging standard. She features a big, self-bailing cockpit and spacious cabin with 6' standing headroom. She sleeps 6 on full 6'3" deeply-cushioned berths (separate forward and after cabins). She offers real live-aboard luxury with dinette, deluxe trim, enclosed toilet area, bulkhead mirror and storage galore. Eight windows and two hatches make her bright and airy. A smooth main cabin liner makes her easy to maintain.

STANDARD: Sleeping for 6 (forward v-berth, double stern berth, two single side berths). Dinette table, chart/cutlery locker, cupboard. Smooth main cabin inner liner. Deluxe cabin trim. Bulkhead mirror. Enclosed toilet area. Plenty of storage. Wide, translucent companionway hatch with teak boards, hasp. Translucent foredeck hatch. Self-bailing cockpit. Cockpit hatch (to wet storage locker). Sealed fuel tank with hatch. Split backstay. 2-tone skid-resistant deck. Hinged mast step. Anodized aluminum mast, boom. Mast carrier. Dacron mainsail. 110% Dacron genoa. Dacron running rigging. Adjustable stainless-steel standing rigging. Harken blocks. Full-length combination toe rail/genoa track. Choice of: fixed keel; or swing keel with lock, silent pennant, winch. Inboard tiller with adjustable up-down rudder (stainless cheeks, rudder post). Mainsail outhaul, downhaul.

Chrysler 22

Owners tell us Chrysler 22 is the biggest 22-footer they've ever been aboard. She has as much space as many larger boats. She comes as a trailerable swing-keel or fixed-keel model; also as a rugged, sturdy, 6'3" standing-headroom "Pop-Top" model.

She sails with amazing stability. Safety includes foot-gripping deck surfaces, self-bailing cockpit, self-righting capability and foam flotation.

Rugged New "Pop-Top" Chrysler 22


Now you can have full, 6'3" walk-around headroom in the main cabin of your "Pop-Top" Chrysler 22. The cabin top itself quickly converts to an extra-sturdy "Pop-Top." Just unsnap the fasteners, set the forward end into a special mast fitting, lift the after end, and slip pins into the four telescoping struts. It opens a whole new vista of cruising comfort and roominess.


The "Pop-Top" snuggles back onto the deck into a soft, water-seal cushion. Snap the fasteners and off you go, dry and comfortable, rain or shine. All four struts telescope neatly out of sight.

Up or down, the full-width hatch slides forward to the mast—and all the way back for sturdy overhead protection. "Pop-Top" model available with swing keel only.

STANDARD: Cabin—5 cushioned berths (6'3"). Dinette table. Fiberglass liner. Port/ starboard windows. Sliding hatch with teak boards. Cockpit-Self-bailing. Sealed storage for fuel tank. New Chrysler 20

Chrysler introduces the "day cruiser." A self-righting, self-bailing 20-footer that brings you the best of both daysailer and cruising sloop design!

Her spacious cockpit (where sailing families spend most of their time) is a whopping 10' long. There's a molded-in fuel tank locker; seats that can convert to extra berths; convenience options like dinette table, remote outboard controls and more.

The surprisingly big cuddy cabin has provisions for full-length V-berth cushions, an optional marine toilet, two quarter berth

cushions, galley and ice chest.

The easy-up-down swing keel with built-in lock and silent pennant is recessed in a ballasted half keel for extra room inboard. Foam flotation makes her safe and quiet. When the wide cabin hatch is open there's standing headroom in the galley area. Cockpit seats and deck surfaces are textured for non-skid safety. Built-in translucent panels provide light for both quarter berths. She's rigged for simplicity and action -easy trailering, rigging, launching, loading and sailing. Mainsail, 110% genoa and rigging are all included.

STANDARD: Swing keel with lock and silent stainless-steel pennant. Kick-up rudder with inboard tiller. Self-bailing cockpit. Waterline and cove striping. Sliding hatch. Textured seats and cabin top. Fuel tank locker. Double v-berth, two quarter berths (cushions optional). Smooth fiberglass cabin headliner. Quality hardware. Harken blocks. Dacron mainsail (provisions for jiffy reefing). 110% genoa. Halyards and sheets. Stainlesssteel standing rigging. Anodized aluminum spars.


Considered by experts to be a breakthrough in performance design, Buccaneer's unique hull shape with long, lean bow and wide, flat stern lines makes her easy to drive to windward, quick to plane, yet surprisingly stable, dry and easy to handle even for the novice. Her spacious 7'3" cockpit with molded-in skid-resistant seats, deck and floor, plenty of storage, and rear deck hatch large enough for an outboard motor, make her an enviable family picnic sailer.

This performance purebred is so beautifully balanced and easy to handle, beginners learn the ropes quickly and season sailors perform circles around competition.

Chrysler Mutineer





Chrysler Pirateer


Chrysler's 13' planing-hull sailing dinghy is portably light in weight, yet safe, stable and forgiving for beginners . . . a great trainer . . . a family fun boat . . . or a winning challenger for experienced sailors. Handsome, wide-open and beamy with a powerful bow, she has foam flotation in hull, spars and between hull and deck for safety. She'll hold 2-3 people with ease. Her sloop rig—mainsail, jib and optional spinnaker—is easy to handle and enables her to walk away from other boats of her type, even in the lightest of breezes. If knocked down, she's easily righted by a single hander.

She's practically maintenance-free with her smooth fiberglass hull, textured anti-skid surfaces and corrosion-resistant rigging, hardware and fittings. Her design and style give her the look of bigger sloops.

STANDARD: Dacron mainsail, jib, halyards and sheets. Jib sheet cleats (2) recessed into seats for convenience and comfort. Anodized aluminum mast and boom with built-in foam flotation. Hinged mast step for quick, easy rigging and unrigging. Kick-up rudder. Wooden locking daggerboard. Hiking stick on tiller. Textured, skid-resistant surfaces. Molded-in seats. Stainless-steel standing rigging. Husky bow and stern eyes. Smooth fiberglass inner hull liner. Provision for an ice box in the stern. Foam hull flotation. Transom drain.

The hi-performance, quick-planing, 14'6" Chrysler Dagger. Low, light, sleek and sassy, she's ready to challenge the best of the hot boats with a single-hander or crew of two. For leisurely fun boating she sails easily on her lines with 2-3 people. Should she capsize, one person can pop her back up and sail away while her double cockpit bails itself dry. Hull is foam-filled for positive flotation. Dagger is easy to rig, handle, trailer or carry on car top. Cat-rigged Dacron sail is loose-footed. Halyard is inside the stayed mast for minimal wind resistance. All running gear-including updown rudder, pivoting tiller extension, foilshaped daggerboard and mainsheet—is located so a single-hander can control her without moving inboard from the hiking position. Chrysler Dagger . . . a new class of one!
